Primary Lesson ~ Building Foundational Friendships

Friendship is normal to life. We were not meant to live alone and God has given us the ability and desire to build a life with other people. These friendships can either add to our foundation (Jesus) and strengthen it or they will slowly chip away at it, undermining the work He has been doing. When the storms of life begin to rise around the foundation of any relationship, the true strength of that relationship will be tested.

There is only one way to determine if a friendship you have is based on Jesus or on something else. Jesus said that we can know a tree by its fruit. If you see an apple tree it will produce apples, not oranges. What type of fruit are the friendships in your life producing? If the fruit is bad, the tree is bad, and the more you eat of that fruit, the more you will find yourself compromising and allowing your conscience to become hardened.

God wants us to invest our lives in areas that are going to have an eternal payoff. As with marriage and family, God knows that friendships are meant to be enjoyed forever. Jesus paid a huge price for us, His friends, and wants to share His life with us. Do you have friends that are unaware of your relationship with Jesus? Do you think that they would like to know this man Jesus? What are you doing to communicate your faith in him to the people you call your friends?

Discussion Questions

1. Discuss Matthew 7:24 and apply the principle to your lives and relationships. What was main point Jesus was trying to illustrate?
2. Discuss the types of fruit that are being produced in your relationships. Use Galatians 5:16-26 as your guideline. This will give you a good indication of the active root structure.
3. Discuss the expressions "Hurt people hurt people". Are there people in your life who hurt you or others on a regular basis? Are you one of the "Hurt" people and are you unknowingly hurting those closest to you?
4. Discuss why it is so hard to talk to family and friends about Jesus and what he has done for you? (Hint: See Mark 6:4-6)



Complimentary Story ~ Dog Saves Owner

A US dog has won an award for saving her owner's life by dialing a phone number that alerted emergency services to her owner's diabetic seizure. The dog was trained to detect potential diabetic attacks by licking and sniffing Mr. Weaver's nose to check his blood sugar levels and pawing him. Belle the beagle triggered a call to an ambulance crew by biting on her owner, Kevin Weaver's, mobile phone. Belle resorted to dialing for help when Mr. Weaver fell unconscious.

The dog used her teeth to press the number nine key, which the phone was programmed to interpret as a "911" call to emergency services.

Ambulance workers answered the phone and, hearing nothing but barking at the end of the line, rushed to the caller's house in the city of Ocoee in Florida State. The dog is the first animal to receive the Vita Wireless Samaritan Award.

"I am convinced that if Belle wasn't with me that morning, I wouldn't be alive today," Mr. Weaver said. "Belle is more than just a life-saver. She's my best friend."
